Our 2025/2026 school year is off to a great start. We thank students and families for helping us make a smooth transition into the start of our year together.

Curriculum Night

Our curriculum night will take place on September 10 at 6:00pm. This gives parents/guardians an
opportunity to meet their child's first semester teachers and learn about course outcomes and
expectations as well as assessment and evaluation practices. Curriculum night is not intended for
individual conversations about a student's progress, but rather to lay the foundation for your understanding
and partnership in assisting your son/daughter to be successful in their studies. You will follow your child's
Day Monday schedule (ABCD). Each session will be 12 minutes with five minutes to move between classes.
Please log into PowerSchool to access your child's schedule.

School Picture Day

• Monday is picture day for all students who did not have their pictures taken this week. You will be called to the gym to have your school picture taken. This is mandatory for all students.

School Fees

A reminder that school fees are \$25 and can be paid by cash or cheque. Please see the office to pay fees.

Course Change Requests

- The last day for students to request a course change is Monday, September 8 at 3:30pm.
- Requests must be made by students going to their graduating year Google Classroom and submitting the course change form.
- Note that it may take three business days. Students should frequently check their PowerSchool to see if the
 change was able to be made. If the change cannot be made, one of our guidance counsellors will email the
 student to advise. Teacher changes for the same course will not be accepted.

Demographic Form Updates

On September 9, the Demographic Updates Form will be available to families in the PowerSchool Parent
Portal. This form should be updated by every family to ensure all information about your child is current,
including contacts, medical information, consents and demographics. Even if there are no anticipated
changes, please still review this information and submit the form. This information will then be reviewed by
the school before updates are finalized. This deadline to submit the form is October 6, 2025.

Student Bus Dismissal at CPA

- School busses will board students eight busses at a time in the bus loop.
- Students should add the Bus Dismissal Google Classroom code: **ur2clie**. This is where bus numbers will be posted when they are ready to board students.
- Students should board their bus as soon as they see their bus number posted.
