Here is what is happening this week and the month ahead.

Curriculum Night at CPA

Due to a number of storm days and our calendar moving ahead, our curriculum night will now take place on February 11 from 5:00-6:00pm. This gives parents/guardians an opportunity to meet their child's second semester teachers and learn about course outcomes and expectations as well as assessment and evaluation practices. Curriculum night is not intended for individual conversations about a student's progress, but rather to lay the foundation for your understanding and partnership in assisting your son/daughter to be successful in their studies. You will follow your child's Day Monday schedule (ABCD). Each session will be 10 minutes with five minutes to move between classes. Please log into PowerSchool to access your child's schedule. The room numbers in the order of ABCD will be the most important information for you to have.

What you can expect:

- Host families receive a tax-free monthly stipend to help cover hosting expenses (\$825 current, \$875 effective September)
- Students stay for periods of three to 10 months
- Ongoing support is provided by an experienced Homestay Coordinator
- You will learn about and communicate with your student before their arrival
