Charles P. Allen High School Final Assessment Information for Parents/Guardians

Purpose of Final Assessments Final assessments assess students' understanding and application of the concepts and skills related to the expected learning outcomes for a subject or course. They can take many forms, including, but not limited to, presentations, portfolios, interviews, and examinations.

If an examination is the chosen format for a final assessment, it must take place during the timeframe specified by EECD.

Final Assessments (not in the form of an Examination) Specific subjects and teachers may complete final assessments during regular class times the week prior to the Summative Assessment (Examinations) period. Individual teachers will be communicating additional information to students and families. These assessments provide valuable information on student achievement of the learning outcomes. It is important that students be present for these assessments, as they cannot be easily rescheduled.

Final Assessment (Examination) Final assessments in the form of an examination will take place on **June 22-25**. Students are expected to attend all classes leading up to examinations.

Student Reminders

Attendance: Students are expected to attend all classes leading up examinations. Students must be in class. They cannot be in the building and not in class.

Academic Integrity: Students may not have phones, smartwatches, or other electronic devices at their desks during assessments.

Be Prepared: Get a good night's rest and eat a healthy breakfast or lunch! The school will have snacks on hand as students arrive for exams.

Textbooks: All textbooks should be returned to the library after students final summative assessments.

CPA Drama Production – 12 Angry Jurors

Under the direction of teacher François Weber, a dedicated group of high school students have been working toward a powerful production of 12 Angry Jurors.

Following the closing arguments of a murder trial, twelve jurors must deliberate a verdict that will determine the fate of an inner-city teen, with a guilty decision carrying the weight of a death sentence. As tensions rise and personal biases emerge, one juror begins to question the evidence, challenging the group's assumptions and forcing a deeper examination of justice, prejudice, and reasonable doubt.

This production represents the culmination of extensive extra-curricular commitment, including hours of rehearsal, workshops, and collaborative practice, offering students a meaningful opportunity to develop their craft and perform for a live audience. To heighten the play's intensity, CPA Players will stage the performance in the round within an intimate studio setting, placing the audience at the centre of the action and immersing them in the pressure and moral complexity of deciding a young person's fate.

The production will take place June 4 and 6 at 7:30pm in the drama room at CPA. Tickets are limited.
